**NOTICE**

**Subject: Opportunity to Appeal Against Non-Recommendation under Guru–Shishya Parampara (Repertory Grant) Scheme for Grant Years 2024–25 and 2025–26 – reg.**

This is to inform all concerned organizations whose applications for financial assistance under the *Guru–Shishya Parampara (Repertory Grant) Scheme* for the grant years 2024–25 and 2025–26 have not been recommended (except those figuring in the Cooling-off list), that they are being provided with an opportunity to submit an appeal against the decision of non-recommendation. The Minutes of the said grant years are available on the website.

2. Organizations intending to appeal must submit their representation along with complete and verifiable supporting documents and records. The appeal should clearly justify the grounds for reconsideration.

**A. Supporting Documents (if not already submitted earlier on the online portal)**

- i. Registration Certificate along with Memorandum of Association/Trust Deed, Bye-laws, and duly filled Resolution in the prescribed format.
- ii. Audited Statements of Accounts for the financial years 2021–22, 2022–23, 2023–24 and 2024–25, including details of sources of funds and pattern of receipts & payments, income & expenditure statements covering all activities of the organization including the cost of productions and workshops organized under the scheme.
- iii. Income Tax Assessment Orders for the last three years along with Balance Sheets duly certified by a Chartered Accountant.

**B. Cultural Activities organized under the banner of the organization (Mandatory as per Scheme Guidelines):**

i. Proof of at least **two productions organized per year during 2021–22, 2022–23, 2023–24 and 2024–25**. Supporting evidence must include:

- Publicly accessible YouTube links
- Other social media links
- Photographs/images
- Press reviews and advertisements
- Souvenir copies, tickets, or any other relevant documentation of these productions

ii. Proof of conducting **a minimum of two cultural workshops in schools**, including:

- Certificates issued by the Principal/Head of the concerned school
- Supporting photo/video evidence

3. All appeals must be submitted **through email** ([Repertory-Grant@gov.in](mailto:Repertory-Grant@gov.in)) from **15<sup>th</sup> April to 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2026** with the subject matter stating '**Opportunity to Appeal Against Non-Recommendation under Guru–Shishya Parampara (Repertory Grant)**'. Requests received after the stipulated date will not be considered. The appeals along with the submitted documents will be examined in the next meeting of Evaluation Committee as per the provisions of scheme guidelines and the decision taken by the Ministry in this regard shall be final.
