Minutes of the meeting of Steering Committee held on 12.03.2026 under the Scheme Component of 'Financial Assistance to Cultural Organizations with National Presence' for the grant year 2025-26.

A meeting of the Steering Committee under the Chairpersonship of Smt. Vandana Jain, Additional Secretary & Financial Adviser was held on 12.03.2026 to examine the proposals received under the scheme of Financial Assistance to Cultural Organizations with National Presence for the grant year 2025-26 and to decide the quantum of financial assistance to the deserving organizations. The following Members have also attended the meeting: -

2. At the outset Smt. Amita Prasad Sarbhai, AS (P. Arts Bureau), MoC welcomed the Chairperson and all the members of the Committee and gave a brief outline of the Scheme component, eligibility criteria and its relevant guidelines.

3. The committee was informed that out of 171 proposals received in response to the advertisement; 162 were received by the last date of receipt of application i.e. 31st December, 2025. However, the committee was of the view to consider the proposal of the organizations even if submitted beyond cutoff date. Accordingly, the 09 proposals received after due date were also put up before the Steering Committee.

4. The Committee examined in detail the proposals submitted by the organizations, taking into account their profiles, the subject, duration, and estimated cost of the project proposals, as well as the amount of financial assistance sought from the Ministry. Further, the Committee took into consideration: -

- (i) the expenditure incurred by the organization/trust on cultural activities during any three years out of the last five years, along with the activities undertaken by the organization; and
- (ii) the provisions laid down in the scheme guidelines, which state that, in exceptional cases, the Ministry of Culture reserves the right to relax any of the criteria of the guidelines on the recommendations of the Steering Committee, for reasons to be recorded in writing.



5. Further, the Committee opined that, in order to provide an opportunity to new and deserving entrants by relaxing the criteria prescribed under the scheme guidelines, the financial assistance extended to regular grantee organizations may be curtailed or discontinued.

6. Further, after detailed deliberation and evaluation of organizations profile and capacity, the Steering Committee recommended the financial assistance to the 30 organizations amounting to ₹640.00 lakhs, as per details given below: -


